Virginia

In dramatic fashion, Virginia ushered in three pro-life, pro-family, conservative Republicans, who will serve in key state offices: Governor Bob McDonnell, Lt. Governor Bill Bolling, and Attorney General Ken Cuccinelli.

The stunning victory is attributed solely to the voting block of the students, faculty and staff at Liberty University. Chancellor Jerry Falwell Jr. encouraged the students at Liberty to register and vote locally, resulting in more than 3,000 new voters. The majority of the students vote in Precinct 20 at Heritage Elementary School. The students voted for pro-life and pro-family values and for limited government.

New Jersey

Conservative and pro-family values **swept through New Jersey, typically a Democratic stronghold**, where incumbent Gov. John Corzine was defeated by his Republican challenger, Chris Christie.
